

Fr Michael Keating will be giving four conferences centered on the following passage from 2nd Corinthians Chapter 1, verse 3-7:

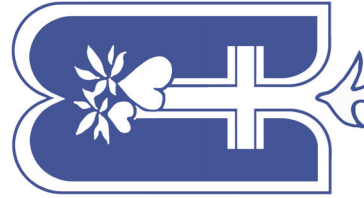

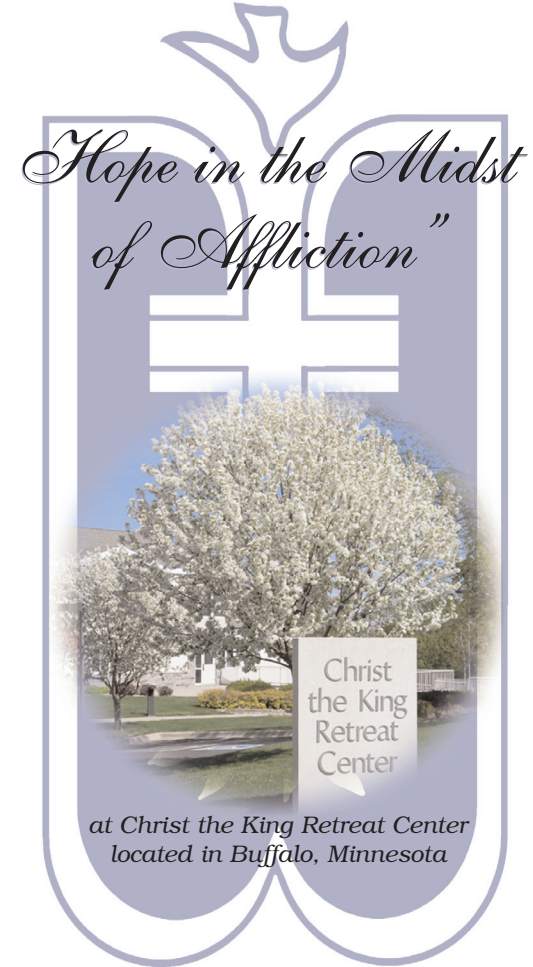

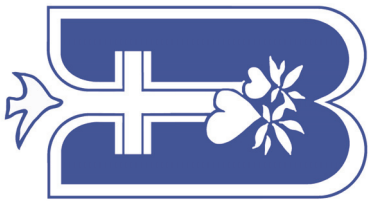

Retreat master: Father Michael Keating was ordained in 2002 and was an Associate Pastor at St. John the Baptist in New Brighton for three years. He is currently a Professor in the Catholic Studies department at the University of St. Thomas in St . Paul MN. Father has an MA in Theology from the Anglicum University in Rome and his PhD in Modern European History from the University of Notre Dame.

Health care professionals often face emotional and spiritual challenges in their work of caring for others. Yet, we are called to be "...guardians and servants of human life" (*The Gospel of Life*, 89). This weekend retreat allows time to focus on the intrinsic value of our vocation as instruments of the healing love of Christ: to care lovingly for those who are sick.

The retreat: Those who are called to care for the sick are called in a special way into the mystery of suffering. As we serve those who are afflicted, we can gain wisdom and hope by more deeply understanding the mind of Christ regarding suffering. We can also understand our own suffering as part of our vocation, and learn to turn our own suffering to the task of comforting others who are afflicted.
