**Many times your best bet will be to make a list of companies you would be interested in, call and ask for a name or email address for someone you might speak with about internships. That personal touch sometimes makes all the difference, and many times companies won't really advertise their internships.

***I've noticed that those internships that are posted on the UST site are generally unpaid, whereas many non-posted internships require they pay interns.

****Internship length will vary from semester to six months, with many companies expecting a full-time employee. Be sure to format your semester schedule in anticipation of this.
