Two ways to save on prescription drugs

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It's like finding extra money every time you fill

Prescription drugs can be expensive. That's nothing new. But at Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota we're doing something about it. Now you have two ways to save money on your medications.*

1

Ask for a three-month supply

If you have prescriptions that you fill regularly, you can get a three-month supply and save. With the 90dayRx program, you decide how you'd like to get your prescriptions. You can have them delivered right to your home, or you can go to your participating neighborhood pharmacy and have the prescriptions filled on the spot. No matter which you choose, the savings you'll get will be the same.

How to use 90dayRx at the pharmacy

- Step 1** Ask your doctor to write your prescription for a 90-day supply (or the maximum days' supply allowed by your plan.) You can also ask your pharmacist to ask your doctor.
- Step 2** Go to a pharmacy that is a part of the program. You'll find one near you by going online to **bluecrossmn.com** and selecting "prescription drugs" under Quick Links and then "90dayRx."
- Step 3** Tear off one of the cards on this brochure and show it to your pharmacist. It has instructions to make sure you get the full discount savings.

*Check with your employer or check your contract to make sure your plan includes these programs.

How to use 90dayRx with home delivery

- Step 1** Ask your doctor to write your prescription for a 90-day supply.
- Step 2** Ask your benefits department for a PrimeMail order form. You can also get the form online from **bluecrossmn.com** by selecting "prescription drugs" and then clicking on "Mail order pharmacy" or by calling the customer service number on the back of your member ID card.
- Step 3** Fill out the order form and mail it with your prescription and payment to PrimeMail, our 90dayRx by mail administrator. You can order refills online by going to **bluecrossmn.com**, selecting "prescription drugs" under Quick Links and clicking on "Order refills" or by calling 1-877-357-7463.

Always ask about generics

Ask your doctor if there is a generic version of your prescription drug. If there is, you'll be getting a drug that works just the same and you'll save a lot of money. If there isn't a generic version, ask your doctor if there is another generic that would work just as well. It never hurts to ask, and you could see a big difference in price. To see if your prescription has a generic version, go to **bluecrossmn.com** and choose "prescription drugs" under Quick Links and then "About the drug list." Then click on "Search the drug list (formulary)" on the left side.

Our member may ask for your help contacting the doctor to make sure the prescription is written for a three-month supply.



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
