## Honors Sections for Spring 2020

## REVISED: April 6, 2020

All honors sections are 4 credits.

Honors sections are all published in the Schedule of Classes. Honors sections numbers are usually 41, although in the case of a department with multiple honors sections, 40 or 42 may be used as honors section numbers. Honors labs will have a different section number than regular lab classes, typically 71 or 72. In addition to this, honors sections are identified with the word "Honors" or an abbreviation of honors, such as HONR, at the beginning of the course title. Honors sections must have **BOTH** markers – section number in the 40s and a title that contains the word or abbreviation for honors.

Each department determines when or if they will offer an honors section. The Aquinas Scholars Honors Program usually does not receive advance notice of honors section offerings. Please contact the department directly to inquire about future honors sections beyond spring 2020.
