WHAT:

- Funding for up to 15 dissertation credits
- Mentoring opportunity

HOW:

Submit the following to the Murray Institute

Faculty Committee:

- A resume
- A 1-2 page narrative description of the intended research
- A 1-page rationale for the importance of the Ed.D.-program-approved topic in light of the Murray Institute's mission (see brochure and website: www.stthomas.edu/murrayinstitute) and its relevance to the Archdiocese/national Catholic education and its ministries

- A 1-2 page endorsement/ recommendation from a graduate of the UST Ed.D. program currently serving in a leadership position in the Archdiocese OR of an Archdiocesan leader. (The endorsement should speak to the applicant's ability to complete this research/program and the importance of the selected topic.)
- A description (amount and frequency) of any financial assistance already received, i.e. professional development funding from place of employment
- Contact information: mailing address, email, phone, etc.
- If requested by Murray, attend a Murray Institute Faculty meeting to further explain the research topic and explore additional resources.

WHEN:

For full consideration,

- Apply the beginning of the semester prior to the semester for which funding is requested (e. g. apply the beginning of fall semester for spring funding).

Notification of acceptance and amount of funding will be made before SOE registration dates for upcoming semester.
