

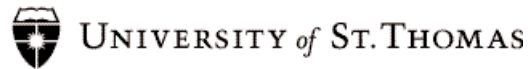

The University of St. Thomas offers this summer day camp as a means of outreach to the community, sharing the resources of this beautiful campus and McCarthy Gym. The summer day camp program offers children ages 3 to 12 a variety of activities that focus on: recreation, the natural world, diversity, environmental issues, and the arts.

Preschool: 3- and 4-Year-Olds

Activities are planned around a weekly theme and may include games, nature activities, arts and crafts, and music. All campers have swimming lessons and rest time daily. Children must be *fully* toilet trained to attend. No diapers or pull-ups allowed.

Junior counselors also will spend part of their day working directly with the campers under the guidance of the counselors. Swimming lessons are included for all junior counselors.

Camp Activities

Imagine your child making new friends ... going on a bubble gum hike ... learning new swimming skills ... having a cookout ... making a candle ... participating in a bug race ... observing the natural world around us ... going on a pond study ... tie-dyeing a T-shirt ... playing games in the gym ... gaining an understanding of another culture.

Camp activities are focused around weekly themes that are environmental or multicultural in nature. Each day is balanced between active, quiet, nature/outdoor, and artistic activities.

Red Cross swimming lessons are provided each day for preschool through Level 6 under the direction of certified Red Cross water safety instructors.

Many walking field trips are provided on a regular basis.

Camp Will Provide

- Qualified counselor – one for every eight to 10 children
- Qualified preschool counselor – one for every five children
- Certified Red Cross water safety instructors
- Milk for lunch
- Fun, learning, meaningful experiences
