The Department of Public Safety would like to inform the UST community of three important occurrences over the past weekend on the Minneapolis Campus.

**BURGLARIES:** Early morning on Saturday, 04:05 July 10<sup>th</sup> a street level window on 10<sup>th</sup> Street, MHO, was smashed out with a rock and a computer system was taken.

Early morning Monday 00:14, July 12<sup>th</sup> a St Thomas Public Safety found a street level window on LaSalle Ave had been smashed out, again, with a rock. It is unknown at this time if any items were taken.

**Vehicle Break-in:** At 22:16 a Public Safety officer on routine patrol discovered a car break-in in progress on 11<sup>th</sup> Street east of Harmon place. Suspect pushed a bicycle into the officer. The officer pushed the bike back at the suspect and a foot chase ensued. Public Safety immediately notified Minneapolis Police. Suspect was able to evade the Public Safety Officer.

Suspect is described as a young black male, 23-30, shaved head, 5'8" tall approximately 160 pounds. Suspect was wearing a long red soccer type jersey, dark pants and a dark hat with a full brim.
