The Department of Public Safety would like to advise the University of St. Thomas community of an incident that occurred on campus.

On Friday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, a St. Thomas student reported that while she was participating in the Wellness 5K Run/Walk along Summit Avenue, a vehicle traveling westbound on Summit Avenue drove past her. An individual inside the vehicle shot paintballs out the window of the vehicle. The student was struck in the leg but was not injured in the incident. The vehicle then disappeared driving southbound on Finn Street.

The suspect vehicle was described as a 4-door, silver Honda Civic. No description of the suspect(s) was obtained.
