Public Safety would like to alert the University of St. Thomas community of a suspicious incident that occurred off campus.

At approximately 11:00 p.m. Sunday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, a St. Thomas student reported that she saw an unidentified male looking into her bedroom window at her residence on Dayton Avenue. The student advised that she yelled at the suspect, and he fled in an unknown direction. The student's roommate ran outside to see if they could locate the suspect, but was unable to.

The suspect is described as a white male in his 30's, with possibly a heavy build, dark hair, receding hair line, thick eyebrows, and wearing glasses. The student only saw the suspect's head through the window, and was not able to get a complete physical and clothing description. The student later filed a report with the St. Paul Police Department.

### Crime prevention tips:

- Remember suspect information, including approximate age, height, weight and details on hair, clothing, jewelry, scars, tattoos – anything noticeable.
- Report crimes immediately to Public Safety and the police.
- Use the Public Safety Escort Service to accompany you to your destination.
- Walk with groups of people – there is safety in numbers.
- Don't take unnecessary risks. Stay in populated, well-lit areas.
- Use a buddy system with your trusted friends to watch out for one another.
