Public Safety would like to inform the University of St. Thomas community of the following Safety Alert received from the St. Paul Police Department.

Saint Paul Police Seek Identity of Assault Suspect

On December 9th a woman was sexually assaulted in the 1800 block of Grand Ave in Saint Paul. The assault occurred at approximately 4:00 A.M. outside the home.

The suspect is described as a white male in his early 20s between 5’8” and 5’10” with a medium build. He has dark brown or black hair that may be long and tucked under a hat. He is described as well groomed and clean shaven. He was wearing black or navy blue knee length “puffy coat” with blue or green panels in the sides or sleeves with a blue knit hat.
