This course focuses on films about Arab lives, stories, and socio-political situations. We will compare fiction and documentary films from three directorial perspectives: that of Arabs living in Arab countries; Arabs in the diaspora around the world, including Arab Americans; and non-Arabs living outside of Arab countries. We will explore issues of representation, self-representation, and the politics of identity; the challenges of cross-cultural communication through film; spectatorship; and different ways of reading a film. We will view at least one film a day--some of them rather short--from a variety of Arab and non-Arab countries, produced since the 1960's, around such themes as colonial struggles for independence ; the Israeli-Palestinian conflict; social life in Arab countries; veiling; and Islamic extremism. Throughout the course, we will examine the act of making and viewing films about Arabs in the current U.S. and international context. This course
