

2009-2010 Bedloft Information for University of St. Thomas

All Bed Lofts come with Safety Rails.

Brady Hall Residents:

- **Rooms 121, 122, 128** - Due to room configuration and door sizes, that allow limited wall space, lofts will not work for these rooms.
- **1st & 2nd FLOOR** - Due to room configuration, only one (1) loft is needed per room, please coordinate with your roommate prior to placing an order.
- **3rd - 7th FLOORS** - Loft-able beds are provided; you cannot replace the beds in these rooms with lofts.
- **EXPANDED Housing** – Loft-able beds are provided; you cannot replace the beds in these rooms with lofts.

Dowling Hall Residents:

- **Rooms 042 and 106** - Due to the room configurations, lofts are not needed in these rooms.
- **5th Floor** - loft-able beds are provided; you cannot replace the beds in these rooms with lofts.
- **EXPANDED Housing** - Loft-able beds are provided to all residents; you cannot replace the beds in these rooms with lofts.
- **ALL OTHER ROOMS** - Are allowed to have 2 lofts in **each room if desired**.

Ireland Hall Residents:

- **1st FLOOR** - Lofts are provided by the University in each room, you do not need to place an order.
- **2nd - 4th FLOOR Double rooms** - Due to room configuration, only one (1) loft is needed per room, please coordinate with your roommate prior to placing an order.
- **ALL FLOORS Triple rooms** - Due to room configuration, lofts are not needed in these rooms.

CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER, CRETIN HALL, FLYNN HALL, GRACE HALL, JOHN PAUL II HALL, MORRISON HALL, & MURRAY HALL RESIDENTS:

- **ALL ROOMS** - Loft-able beds are provided; you cannot replace the beds in these rooms with lofts.
