

CHALLENGES IN CROSS-CULTURAL SUPERVISION

What is the video recording about?

Diversity is increasing among agency clientele, among practitioners and among their supervisors. The purpose of this video recording is to stimulate in-depth thought and discussion regarding the conflicting and complex issues involved in the cross-cultural supervisory relationship. The video consists of three vignettes demonstrating situations that can arise between supervisor and supervisee. The instructor's manual that accompanies the video includes a theoretical framework through which to view the supervisory relationship in general and cross-cultural issues in particular. The manual also provides discussion questions and group activities to facilitate further understanding of the material.
