

Park and Ride Options to the University of St. Thomas

(Minneapolis Campus)

There are many public transit options to the University of St. Thomas's Minneapolis campus. In addition to the 54 unique Metro Transit lines which serve the campus directly, it's possible to incorporate public transit into your commute by using a park and ride station. And did you know that you can combine a public transit trip with the St. Thomas shuttle? Here are some ideas to inspire you!

South

If coming from the South, park at the [Southdale Transit Center and Park and Ride on the corner of W66th St and Xerxes Ave S](#). Board the northbound 6 bus at the Southdale Transit Center & Gate A. Get off at 12th St S & Yale Place. You have arrived at St. Thomas! Total trip time estimate: 38 minutes

North

If coming from the North, park at the [Metro Transit Brooklyn Center Park and ride at 6503 Brooklyn Blvd](#). Walk south to the bus stop at 63rd Ave N & Brooklyn Blvd. Board the southbound 724 bus. Get off at 6th St S & Marquette Ave. Walk to the southwest corner of the block to the bus stop at Nicollet Mall & 7th St S. Board a southbound 6d bus. Get off at Harmon Pl & 11th St S/ 12th St S. Walk north one block. You have arrived at St. Thomas! Total trip time estimate: 52 minutes

East

If coming from the East, park at the park and ride at [Como Ave & Eustis in St. Paul](#). Walk north to the bus stop at Larpent Ave and Eustis St. Board the 61 heading West. Get off at Nicollet Mall & 9th St S. Walk a block west. You have arrived at St. Thomas! Total trip time estimate: 30 minutes

West

If coming from the West, park at the [Wayzata Blvd. & Barry Ave. Park & Ride](#) in Wayzata. Take the 672, 674, or 645 to 12th Street South and Yale Place at the University of St. Thomas in downtown Minneapolis. You have arrived at St. Thomas! Total trip time estimate: 30 minutes
