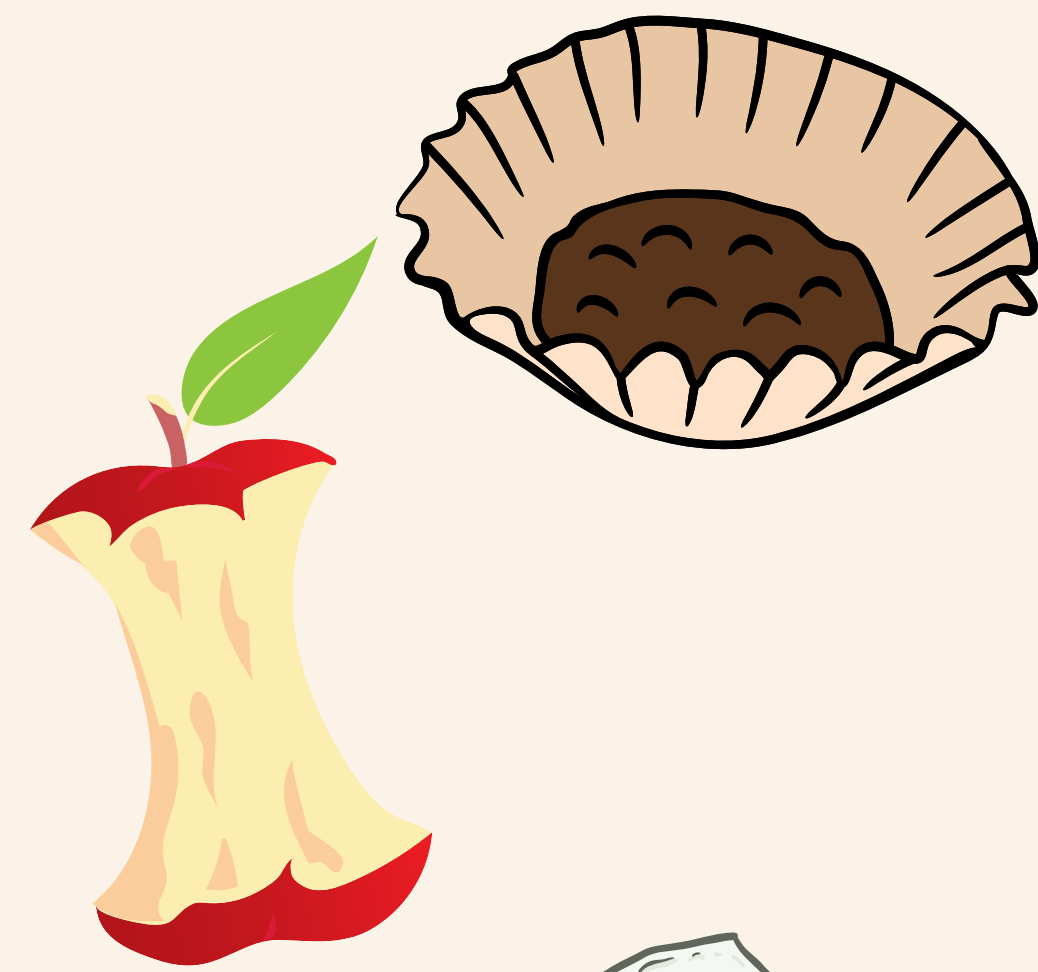


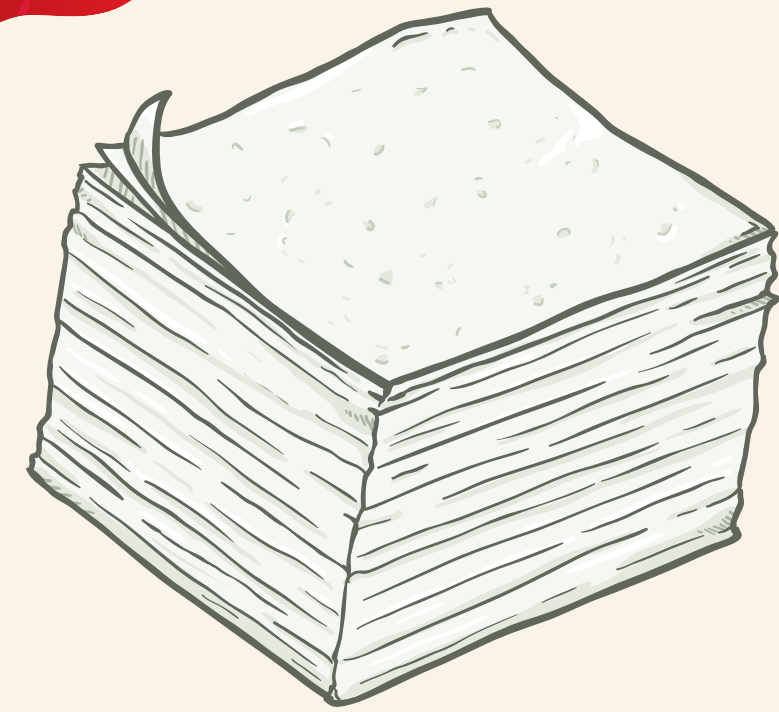
# Residential Compost Expansion FAQ

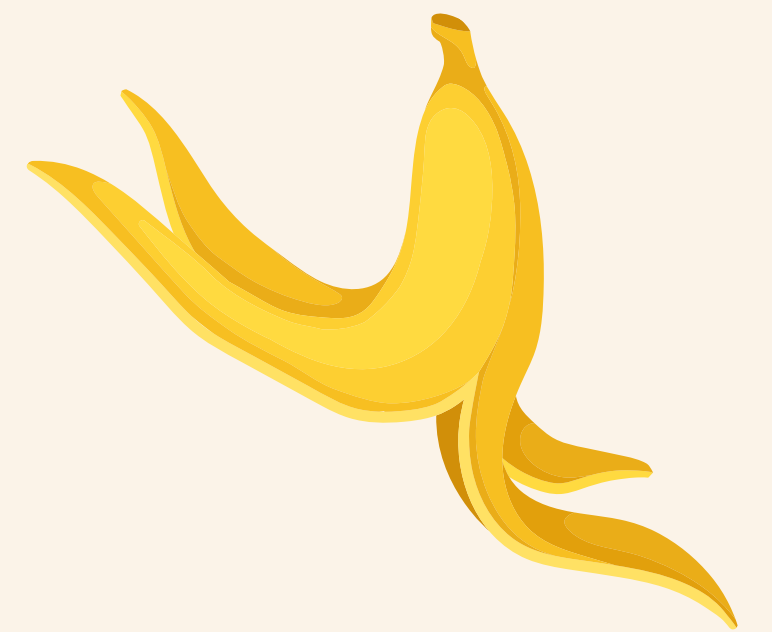
## Why compost organics?

Food scraps in the landfill release methane, which is contributing to global warming. Food scraps and other organic materials that are composted make a rich soil amendment that can be used by farmers to grow healthy food!



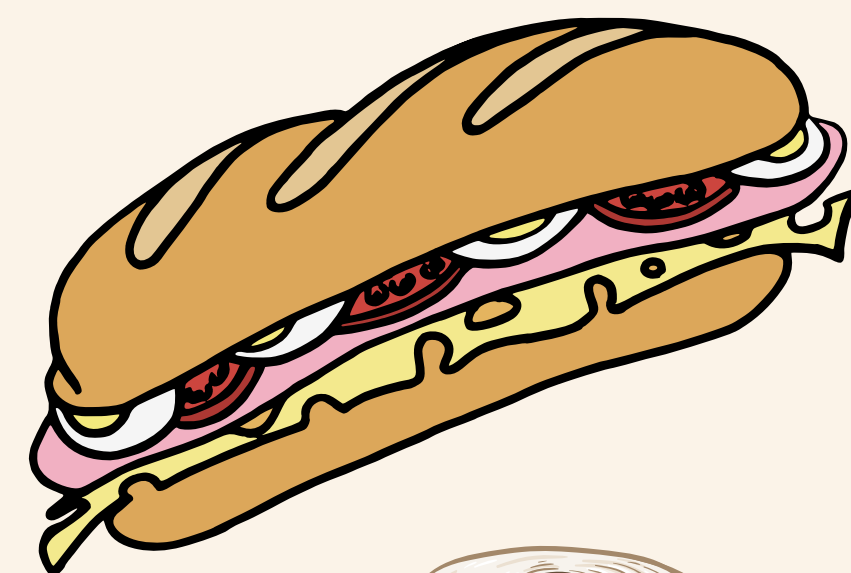
## What goes in the green bin?

All food scraps (including animal products), soiled paper products, BPI certified compostable food ware, and other items such as tea bags, toothpicks, and coffee grounds should go in the green compost bin.



## Where do I empty my bin?

Every waste room on every floor of the residence halls should have a large green bin for organics. Place your room bag in the bin and grab a new bag from the dispenser!



## How do I prevent pests and smells?

- Wipe down your bin frequently
- Regularly empty your bin
