

ALLERGY INJECTION CONSENT

Allergy shots are administered at the University of St. Thomas Health Service (HS) providing that the following stipulations are met:

- Patients must have the initial injection of allergy serum administered by an allergist or private physician.
- Patients must have the serum and detailed injection instructions, with the allergist's name address and phone number, on file at HS. The serum will be kept refrigerated at HS.
- Guidelines from the allergist are to include instructions for missed/late injections along with any history of previous reactions.
- Patient will be responsible for reordering and purchasing serum as necessary. Out-dated serum will not be administered.
- Patient must remain in the HS clinic for a minimum of 20 minutes following the injection and have the injection site checked by a nurse for any reaction before leaving the facility.
- Any reaction that occurs after you leave the HS must be reported to HS staff before the next injection is given.

Injections are only administered when a physician is in clinic. The last allergy injection will be given 20 minutes before the physician's scheduled departure.

The cost for allergy injections will be submitted to your health insurance company. Please provide a copy of your insurance card at time of your appointment.
