### Search for an organization

To search for a organizations, navigate to the *Organizations* tab in the toolbar at the top of your site when you log in. You will be shown all organizations by default. From this list, you can search for an organization by name using the search feature. If you aren't sure of the exact organization you are looking for, you can also explore organizations by Organization Category. Once you have found your organization of interest, click on its name to jump into the organization page.
