REQUIREMENTS FOR MAJOR

Forty-four credits in major, no more than 8 credits of which may be at the 100-level and at least 16 credits of which must be numbered HIST 300 or above.

Four credits from each of the following areas:

- World History: HIST 111, 112, 115
- Regional History: HIST 113, 114, 117, 118, 119

Four credits from each of the following areas:

- Courses with a methodological focus: HIST 216, 263, 266, 207, 211.
- Ancient and Medieval World: HIST 203, 205, 208, 310, 311, 386
- Europe since 1450: HIST 222, 223, 225, 226, 291, 322, 328, 333, 335, 336, 394

- American History: HIST 262, 292, 353, 355, 358, 365, 366, 372, 396
- Africa, Asia, Latin America: HIST 240, 241, 244, 253, 293, 303, 348, 349, 395

Three additional electives (12 credits) from any of the above areas.

Plus:

- HIST 466 Capstone Seminar (4 credits)

REQUIREMENTS FOR MINOR

Twenty credits in minor, no more than 8 credits of which may be at the 100-level and at least 4 credits of which must be numbered HIST 300 or above.
