DEADLINE

All applications, essays, and transcripts should be submitted to Dr. Tanya Gladney (OEC 434) by **noon on Tuesday, April 10, 2018**. Please submit hard copies of all documents listed below.

No late applications or essays will be accepted.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The scholarship recipient must be a student at the University of St. Thomas. The student should have completed 92 credits by the end of the academic year of the scholarship application with a major or minor in criminal justice.

Preference is given for a student interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement. The scholarship funds will help support educational diversity at the university, particularly in its criminal justice program, consistent with the university's mission and admission policy. In awarding the scholarship, special consideration will be given to students who:

- Have demonstrated volunteerism and community service activities and/or
- Have demonstrated how they contribute to educational diversity at St. Thomas and/or
- Have demonstrated how they have overcome personal hardship

SELECTION PROCESS

- Complete scholarship application (additional applications can be found in the Sociology Student Resource Room OEC 438 and posted on Dr. Gladney's office door OEC 434).
- Submit your academic transcript (unofficial).
- Write a two-page, single-spaced essay on how you meet the above criteria. Your essay should address the following:
 - Share your career goals in law enforcement.
 - Share how your diverse background can contribute to the law enforcement field and/or share how you have overcome personal hardship.
 - Share the organization(s) that you have volunteered your service.
