



Rendering of Iversen Center for Faith & Chapel of St. Thomas Aquinas

Project Progress Update

On April 1, 2019 Opus mobilized on site to begin construction of the new expansion of the Chapel of St. Thomas Aquinas, the Iversen Center for Faith.

Opus began sitework by creating a construction entrance, installing jobsite fence and job site trailer. Existing trees were removed and demolition of existing sidewalks and stairs around the chapel.

Excavation began this month with the top soil coming off in early April and deep excavation for foundations starting middle of the month. Veit & Company, Inc. is on site as the earthwork contractor performing this work. Additionally they have been handling the work to underpin the existing chapel foundations. At the middle of the month they began work on a soil retention system along the west side of the chapel. Later in April, installation of soil nails into the existing foundations began.
