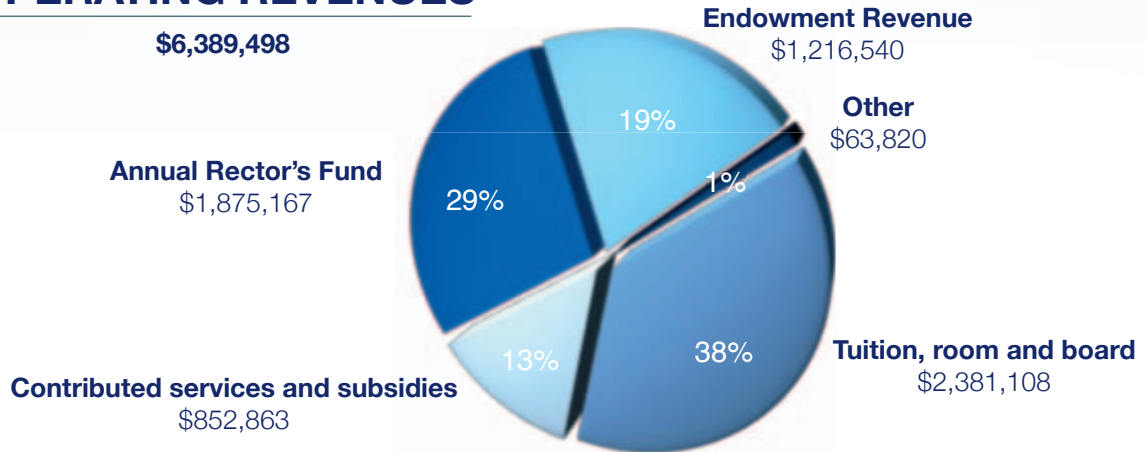

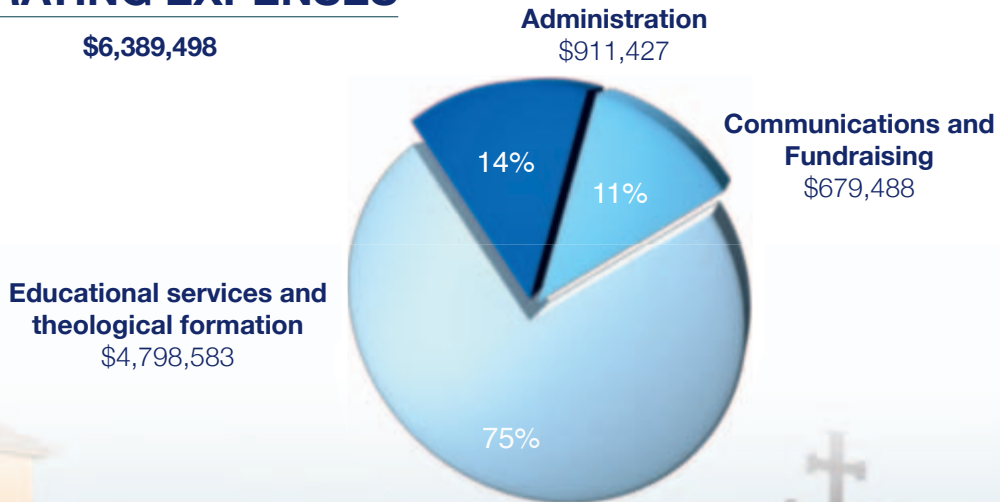

# Impact 2015-2016

**600**

More than 600 people were enrolled in various programs of The Saint Paul Seminary School of Divinity.

**84** seminarians were in formation from 17 dioceses, one institute of religious life, and one religious order.

**16** men were ordained in 2016.

**70**

More than 70 men and women were enrolled in one of three graduate degree programs.

**32**

men were in formation for the Permanent Diaconate.

More than 400 men and women were enrolled in the Archbishop Harry J. Flynn Catechetical Institute.

**16** Theology IV seminarians studied the universal Church while in Rome in January.

**23** Theology III seminarians spent January Term in Jerusalem studying the historical, biblical and ecumenical importance of the Holy Land.
