

ABOUT THE ARTIST

Grethe Krogh is Professor of Organ and Chairman of the Organ Department at the Royal Danish Academy of Music in Copenhagen. She has concertized throughout Europe, Russia and the United States. Her recordings on Lyrichord Discs and EMI have been acclaimed, especially for her performances of Danish music.

Professor Krogh graduated from the Royal Danish Academy of Music with degrees in piano, organ and harpsichord. Additional studies were undertaken with Andre Marchal in Paris. She often serves on juries for international competition. Students from throughout Europe and the United States have traveled to Copenhagen to study with her. She has won many honors, including the coveted prize from the Copenhagen Music Critics and the Tages Brandts Prize of Honor.

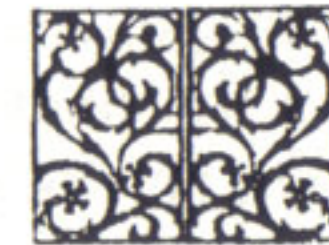
